

Oldham's top 10 tips for wearing face coverings

We all need to play our part in stopping the spread of Coronavirus

1 Hand hygiene and social distancing are still the most important action to take, even when wearing a face covering.



2 Make sure you put the face covering on the right way; avoid touching the front of the mask.



3 Wash your hands thoroughly using hand sanitiser before and after using your face covering.



4 Make sure the face covering fits comfortably and covers your nose and mouth; do not keep adjusting it.



5 Do not share your face covering – it is yours.



6 Do not remove your face covering to talk to anyone or use your phone.



7 You should clean any surfaces your face covering has touched with household cleaner – avoid putting your face covering down on multiple surfaces.



8 Wash your face covering regularly.



9 Dispose of your face covering properly in the normal way – do not litter.



10 Store your face covering in a plastic bag until you use it again.




