

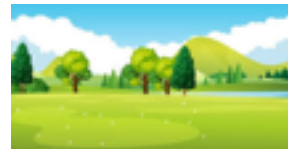

Oldham's RSE sub-committee met last week to discuss the new DfE guidance on the teaching of RSE in Oldham schools. The sub group reflected representation from Oldham Mosques, the Inter Faith Forum, the Catholic Diocese, parent representatives, Primary Headteachers and the Local Authority. To support the process of ensuring that the teaching of RSE is carried out according to legislation in an environment of shared partnership working between schools and parents/carers. A teacher with experience of teaching RSE (now based in the local authority) will prepare some exemplar resources for issue to schools. This should assist schools in planning and sharing their curriculum with parents/carers.

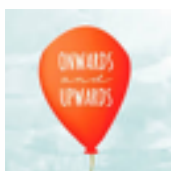
ATTENDANCE
