Aspirations Day

On Monday 2nd December we will be having our annual Aspirations Day. The aim of this day is to raise our pupils' aspirations and encourage them to aim as high as possible. Pupils will have the opportunity to listen to and question a range of people who have chosen different career paths. This will give them an idea of what careers they could choose in the future and what skills each career requires. We will be visited by a range of people including the Mayor, a dentist, neonatal nurse, writer, photographer and a Computer Programmer to name a few.

Enterprise Week/Dragon's Den

Following on from Aspirations Day we will be having a whole school Enterprise Week. The aim of this week will be to develop our pupils' knowledge, skills and understanding of different types of jobs, how money is spent in designing and making products and primarily how they can contribute to a range of activities that help them to become more enterprising. In preparation for the week, each class is allocated a budget of £20 with a remit of designing, advertising and making a product that can be marketed for sale to members of the school community. Each class is challenged to make a profit on their original £20 budget.

Times Tables Rock Stars

From the 2019/20 academic year onwards (this academic year), all schools in England will be required to administer an online multiplication tables check (MTC) to year 4 pupils.



The national curriculum specifies that pupils should be taught to recall the multiplication tables up to and including 12 × 12 by the end of year 4.

The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will help schools to identify pupils who have not yet mastered their times tables, so that additional support can be provided.



We have bought a subscription to TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars) which is a carefully sequenced online programme for children to practise their times tables and division facts. As well as other exciting features, it has a very similar platform (Sound check) as the MTC for children, teachers and parents to check the children's progress.

Times tables knowledge is also key for children in years 5 and 6 to access the Maths curriculum as well as their SATs.

Please encourage your child to access TTRS regularly – daily if possible!
