

Subject overview and Progression of Knowledge and Skills- Geography

Geography Pre Requisites:

Locational knowledge: know the names of the four countries that make up the UK and name 3 main seas that surround the UK; know the names of and locate the seven continents of the world; know the names of and locate the five oceans of the world; know the name of and locate the four capital cities of England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Place Knowledge: know features of hot and cold places in the world; know the main differences between a place in England and that of a small place in a non-europeans country.

Human and Physical Geography: know which is the hottest and coldest season in the UK; know and recognise main weather symbols; know the main differences between city, town and village; identify the following physical features (mountain, lake, island, valley, river, cliff, forest and beach); explain some of the advantages and disadvantages of living in a city or village.

Skills and fieldwork: know where the equator, North Pole and South Pole are on a globe; know which is N, E, S and W on a compass; know their address, including postcode; know and use the terminologies left and right, below; next to.
