#### Ollee - a virtual friend for children (Children in Need)

Ollee is a digital friend for children aged 8-11. He has been created by Parent Zone and funded by Children in Need to make a difference to children's emotional wellbeing. The app encourages children to reflect on how they feel and to process their experiences. It offers them child friendly advice on a range of subjects including friends, family, the internet and the wider world.

For each subject, the children can choose an emotion that matched how they feel, then select the topic they want to talk to the virtual friend about.
