British Isles	A group of islands in West Europe: Great Britain, Ireland, the Isle of Man, and adjacent small islands. 120,592 sq. mi. (312,300 sq. km).		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Great Britain (GB) is made up of England, Scotland and Wales. • The United Kingdom (UK) is made up of England, Wales and Scotland (the island of Great Britain) and Northern Ireland (part of the island of Ireland) plus many other small islands. • The British Isles is made up of England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland (the UK) and the country of the Republic of Ireland. • England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland, the four regions of the UK, are not independent countries, although this is often how we think of them.

county	Any of the administrative or geographic subdivisions of certain states, esp any of the major units into which England and Wales are or have been divided for purposes of local government
