Vocabulary – Goldilocks words

Word	Definition
City	A large town.
Town	A built-up area with a name, defined boundaries, and local government, that is larger than a village and generally smaller than a city.
Continent	A massive area of land that is separated from others by water or other natural features.
NorthWest	The direction towards the point of the horizon midway between north and west.
Settlement	A place, typically one which has previously been uninhabited, where people establish a community.
Industry	Economic activity concerned with the processing of raw materials and manufacture of goods in factories.
