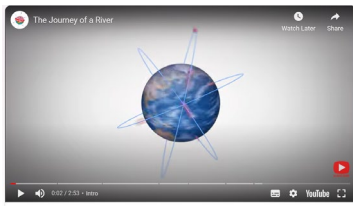
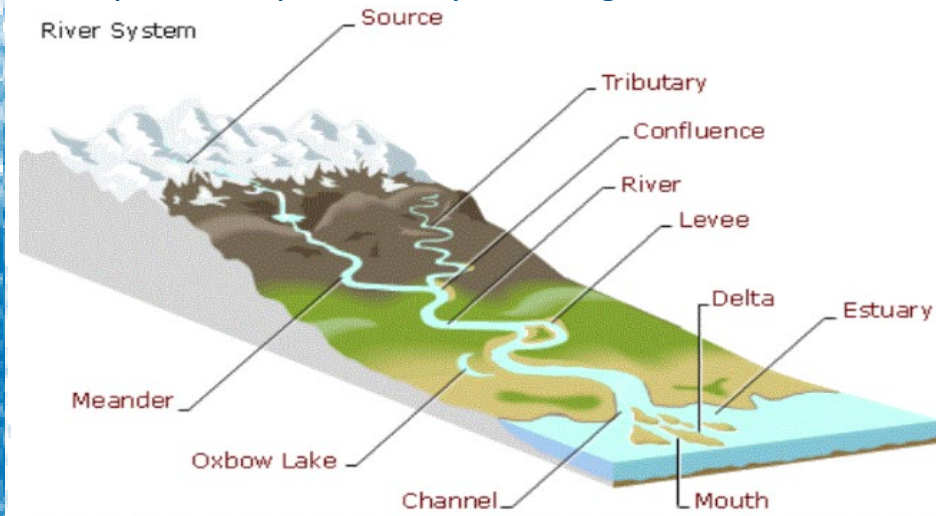
Sticky Knowledge

- The world's largest river is the river Nile which stretches to 4160 miles in length.
- The world's shortest river is the Roe River which measures only 201 feet.
- The water cycle is the way in which the water moves around the Earth. It never stops!
- The river consists of three stages: upper, middle, and lower course.
- The river has many uses around the world: cooking, cleaning, growing crops, transporting, and creating power.
- Flooding is caused by poor drainage around or close to a river.

Vocabulary – Goldilocks words

Word	Definition
Source	This is where a river begins.
Tributary	A river or stream that flows into a larger river or lake.
Confluence	To meeting point of two or more rivers.
Estuary	When a river mouth opens into the sea, the part of the river where freshwater mixes with salt water.
Meander	A natural bend in a river, usually occurring in the middle course.
